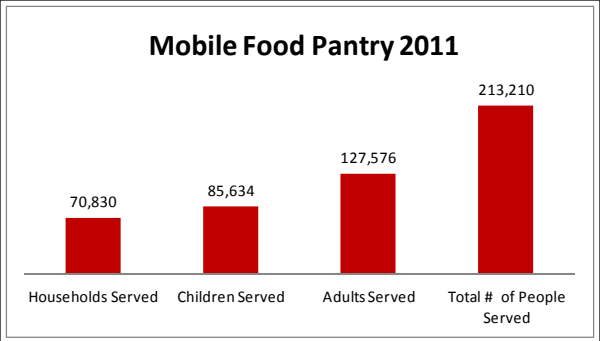




MOBILE FOOD PANTRY BRINGS FOOD TO THE UNDERSERVED

WHAT IS THE MOBILE FOOD PANTRY PROGRAM?

- The Mobile Food Pantry, much like the bookmobiles of the past, delivers nutritious food directly to hungry people in need.
- The Mobile Food Pantry’s purpose is to bring food to areas where there are few food programs or where food programs do not exist.
- Started in 2008, the program brought more than 3.6 million pounds of food to needy people and communities last year.



THE EASE OF THE PROGRAM

- The Mobile Food Pantry eliminates the need for large-capacity or long-term storage.
- Mobile Food Pantry distributions are completed in approximately 2 hours.
- The Mobile Food Pantry provides a household with 50 pounds of food that includes both perishable and non-perishable food items.
- The program improves access to food in underserved areas.

HOW THE MOBILE FOOD PANTRY IS HELPING HUNGRY NEW MEXICANS

- Last fiscal year, the program worked with 103 sites and delivered food 775 times.
- Families with children represent a large portion of the clients helped through the program.
- The Mobile Food Pantry has regular food deliveries in 13 counties we directly serve and has targeted communities with little access to grocery stores or other food programs such as Las Cruces, Luna, Hagerman, Meadowlake, Mescalero, Carrizozo, Cuba, and metro locations such as the Pajarito Mesa, Martineztown, and North Rio Rancho.

BRINGING THE MOBILE FOOD PANTRY TO YOUR COMMUNITY



- Any organization, business or individual may sponsor a Mobile Food Pantry site such as non-profits, religious organizations, businesses, civic groups, individuals, and families.
- Coordinate dates and logistics of your anticipated Mobile Food Pantry delivery with Roadrunner staff.
- Select a site with good parking and accessibility for a tractor trailer.



- The Mobile Food Pantry will deliver food directly to the distribution site.
- Sponsors organize the location, volunteers, and tables to facilitate the food distribution.
- Sponsors spread the word within the community about the scheduled delivery.
